- What is 143?
- What is 122?
- The answer to these questions will help to form statements.
- 143are the number of mango trees and 122 are the number of apple trees. the statements are

- Number of mango trees. 143
- Number of apple trees. + <u>122</u>

Thus / therefore the total number of trees =. 265

<u>Answer=</u>The school planted 265 trees.
