Life in the Himalayan Region

#### Synopsis

- 1. The Himalayan region includes the state of Jammu and Kashmir ,Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Northern Uttar Pradesh, Northern West Bengal Sikkim and North- Eastern states of Tripura, Assam ,Arunachal Pradesh Meghalaya ,Mizoram ,Nagaland and Manipur.
- 2. The Kashmir Valley is very beautiful the Mughal Emperor Jahangir described it as Heaven on Earth it has two capitals Srinagar is the summer capital Jammu as the winter capital. The Dal Lake at Srinagar is a famous tourist attraction .Boats called houseboats are used as hotels the main occupation of the people is farming, fields are cut like steps on the slopes of the hills. Rice, millet and sugarcane are grown here.
- 3. The capital of Himachal Pradesh is Shimla where they grow maize, barley fruits and vegetables many people rear sheep and goats plums and apples are grown here in large quantities woollen carpets, blankets rugs and shawls are woven here. Thousands of tourists visit famous hill stations of Kullu ,Manali ,Shimla and Dalhousie. Dashara is the main festival in the Kullu region where most people speak Hindi ,Punjabi and Kinnauri . Women wear pyjamas with a long top, they wear scarves called Dhazu and the men wear tight pyjamas with loose shirts.
- 4. The Capital of Uttarakhand is Dehradun. The main occupation of the people is agriculture. Many people join the Army. Dehradun is known for the Indian Military Academy Mussoorie, Nainital and Ranikhet are the popular hill stations. Haridwar Kedarnath, Badrinath, Gangotri and Yamunotri are famous tourist places here.
- 5. Darjeeling is famous for its tea Gardens they produce one of the finest qualities of tea. Sikkim is a very small state. It has high mountains and deep river valleys. Kanchenjunga, the third highest peak in the Himalayas, lies in Sikkim. The capital of Sikkim is Gangtok people here belong to three main tribes -Lepcha, Bhutia and Nepali . They celebrate the festival of Saga Dawa.
- 6. North- Eastern states include Arunachal Pradesh, Assam Meghalaya ,Nagaland, Manipur Tripura and Mizoram these states are known as the seven sisters. The people of Nagaland are called the Nagas, they are very brave people the Garo and the Khasis are the inhabitants of Meghalaya they wear bright colourful clothes .People of the hilly areas are fond of singing and dancing. The folk dance of Himachal Pradesh is called Natti. The Kashmiri folk dance is called the Rouf. The bamboo dance of Mizoram and the warrior dance of the Nagas are also very famous.
- 7. All the North -Eastern states are famous for their bamboo items Arunachal Pradesh is known for its cane items.
