TOPIC: THE FOUR OPERATIONS



SYNOPSIS

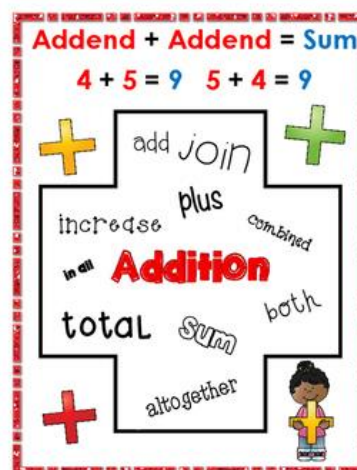
- Large numbers are added or subtracted in the same way as small numbers.
- Numbers can be added in any order. Their sum will remain the same.
- When 0 is added to a number, the sum is the number itself.
- When zero is subtracted from a number, the difference is the number itself.
- Multiplication means repeated addition.
- Numbers can be multiplied in any order, the product will remain the same.
- When a number is multiplied by 0, the product is always 0.
- Division means repeated subtraction.
- When a number is divided by itself, the quotient is 1.
- When zero is divided by a number, the quotient is 0.
- **Dividend = Divisor × Quotient + Remainder**.

EXAMPLES

1. a. Addition

C	TL	L	Tth	Th	H	T	O
3	4	8	1	2	4	7	2
+ 4	3	7	3	9	8	0	2
7	8	5	5	2	2	7	4

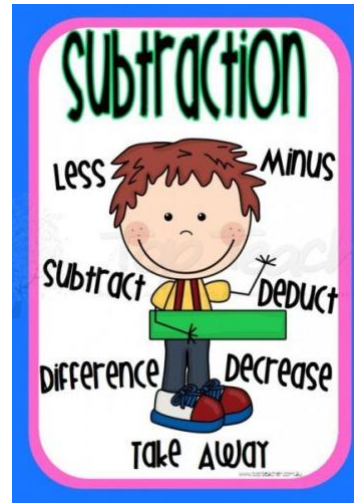
Ans: 7, 85, 52, 274



b. Subtraction

C	TL	L	Tth	Th	H	T	O
4	8	8	6	2	8	3	9
- 2	6	8	1	4	5	1	4
2	2	0	4	8	3	2	5

Ans: 2, 20, 48, 325

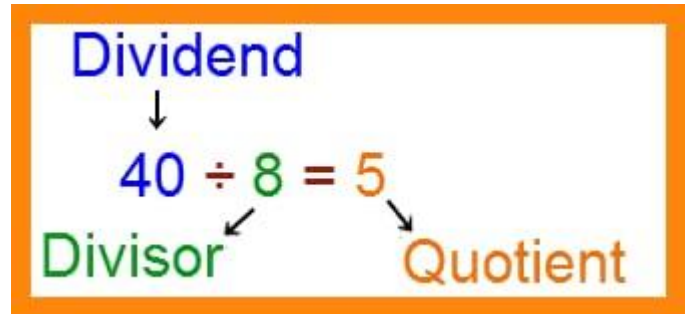


c. Division

$$40120 \div 32$$

$$\begin{array}{r} \underline{1253} \text{ Quotient} \\ 32 \overline{)40120} \\ \underline{32} \\ 81 \\ \underline{64} \\ 172 \\ \underline{160} \\ 120 \\ \underline{96} \\ 24 \text{ Remainder} \end{array}$$

Ans: Quotient = 1253
Remainder = 24

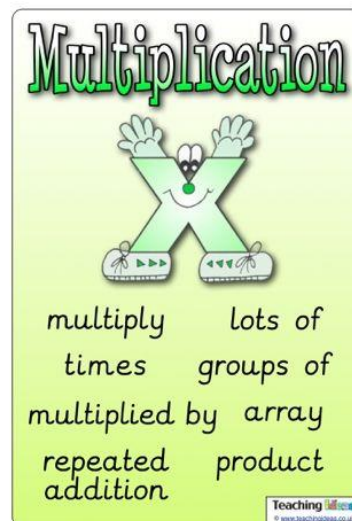


d. Multiplication

$$1434 \times 278$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 1434 \\ \times 278 \\ \hline 11472 \\ 100380 \\ \hline 286800 \\ 398652 \end{array}$$

Ans: 3, 98, 652
