A and An suggest one so they are used before countable nouns in the singular number.

eg: a) a bird

b) an eagle

- We use 'a' before a word beginning with consonant sound.
eg: a) a university
 b) a one rupee note
- Words beginning with silent 'h' take an before them.
eg) a) an hour
 b) an honour
- We use 'the' in the following situations:
a) Before a noun whenever we want to particularise that noun.
eg) The books lying on my table.
 The shoes I bought last evening.
