(SYNOPSIS)

- The model of the earth is called a globe.
- A globe is round like a ball slightly flat at the top and the bottom.
- The surface of the Earth is made up of land and water.
- Different colours are used to show the features on a map.
- Blue parts show the waterbodies and other coloured parts show different countries and continents.
- The earth has seven continents and four main oceans.
- · Large parts of land on the Earth are called continents.
- Large water bodies of water on the earth are called Oceans and smaller water bodies are called seas, bays and gulf s.
- The drawing of the Earth on a flat surface is called a map.
- Maps which show the whole Earth is called World map and maps which are big in size and can be put up on a wall are called Wall maps.
- A book of maps is called an atlas.
- Maps can be drawn for a continent, a country, a city or a town.
- The four main direction are North, South, East and West.
- · Compass helps to locate directions.
