SYNOPSIS

- ❖ Weather is the condition of atmosphere of a particular place for over a short period of time.
- The kind of weather at a place for over a period of many years is called climate.
- Places near the Equator have a hotter climate.
- ❖ As we go higher and higher above the sea level, the temperature goes on decreasing.
- ❖ Places near the sea are neither very hot nor very cold.
- ❖ The direction of wind greatly affects the climate of a place.
