- E.1 a. North was industrial base, wanted improvement in transport and communication. South was against such changes as it would affect soil fertility. The North abolished slavery but continued in the South.
 - 1.b. Crucial role played by Abraham Lincoln guided the Union succeeded in preserving its unity Issued the Emancipation Proclamation and abolished slavery.
 - 2 .a. In the South Tariff seemed unfair and disturbed the economy of Southern States. Imported wider variety of goods from foreign markets. Taxes were also levied on many Southern goods.
 - b. Slavery continued in the Southern States. Slaves were also used for household work. They were tortured and badly treated. They were bought and sold; kept in unhygienic condition, poorly fed were not allowed to read and write. They were punished when they tried to read the Bible.
- **1.** C. When the Emancipation Proclamation was issued, it was a great step in abolishing slavery and setting the slaves free. After the war slaves were granted citizenship and voting rights.
