TOPIC-NUMBERS UP TO 1000.

SUMMARY:-

1.Forming numbers up to 1000.

The numbers 0 to 9 are single digits. Thus we can make any two digits numbers from 0 to 9 like 10 to 99. Likewise we can even make three digits for example-100 as well as four digits for example-1000. We read 77 as seventy seven in words, 1000 as one thousand in words.

2.Place -value- We have numbers placed according to their place-value or rather we can say numbers in their houses. We have the thousand house, hundreds house, tens house and ones house. For example

TH H T O

1000- 1 0 0 0

3.Expanded form- means the place value of the numbers for example-

143-  $100+4+3$

(1) place value is 100 or 1 hundreds.

(4) place value is 40 or 4 tens.

(3) place value is 3 or 3 ones.

4.Comparing numbers-

Which number is greater than or lesser than. For example- Sita has 20 pens whereas Gita has 140 pens. Who has more pens?

Gita has more pens than Sita because Sita has two digits whereas Gita has 3 digits. 3 digits numbers are always greater than 2 digits.
