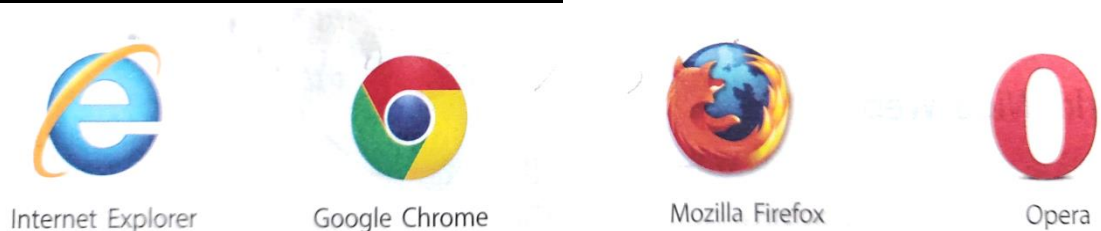


Fig. 4.4 Popular web browsers
