- We can divide the world into three climatic regions – the Tropical Region ,the Temperate Region and the Polar Region.
- Regions lying between the Tropics are called the Tropical Regions.
- The regions between the Tropic of Cancer and the Arctic Circle, and between the Tropic of Capricorn and the Antarctic Circle are called the Temperate Regions.
- Regions between the North Pole and the Arctic Circle, and between the South Pole and the Antarctic Circle are called the Polar Regions.
- The area around the Equator is hot and wet throughout the year.
