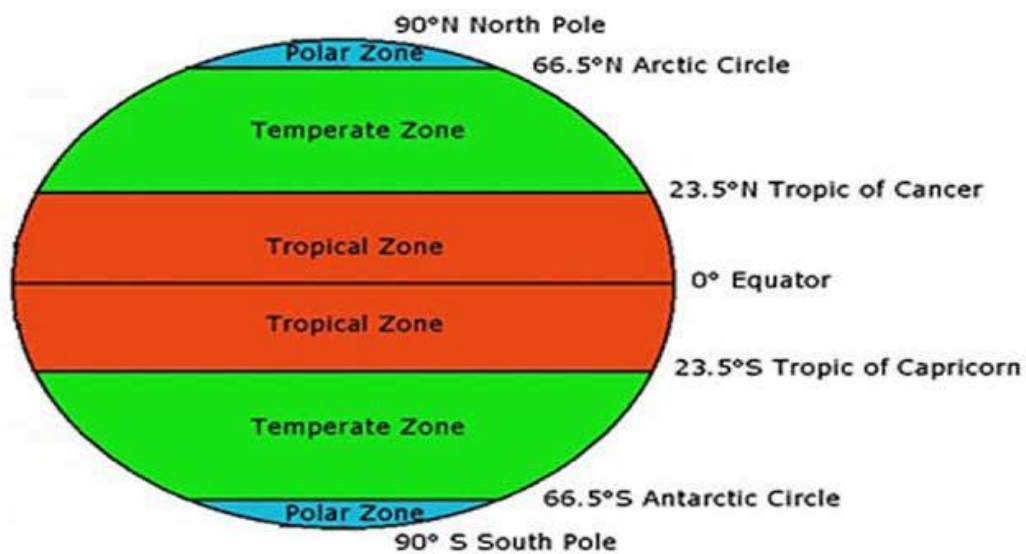

1. Broad areas having similar type of climate are called climatic regions.

2. The Tropical regions generally have a hot and wet climate. These areas experience rainfall almost every afternoon. Some areas have monsoon type of climate while other areas have a hot and dry desert type of climate. Two places having a tropical climate are :- India and Malaysia.

3. The regions between the Tropic of Cancer and the Arctic Circle and between the Tropic of Capricorn and the Antarctic Circle are called the Temperate Regions.

In the Temperate Regions , the sun does not shine directly. The summers are not so hot and the winters are very cold.

4. In the Polar region , the summers are very short and cold . Winters are very long and extremely cold. This region is frozen for most of the year.
