SYNOPSIS:

A word that describes a person, place, animal or thing is called a **describing word**. All describing words are **adjectives**.

For Example –

- Shyam has a red shirt.
- Sangita is a sweet girl.
- Kolkata is a big city.
- He has a white dog.

In these sentences, the words **red**, **sweet**, **big** and **white** are adjectives.

There are different kinds of adjectives. Here are some:

1. Adjectives of Colour: red, blue, dark, light, etc.

For Example – It is a **red** shirt.

2. Adjectives of Size : big, small, large, etc.

For Example – A tiny ant lives in a large house.

3. <u>Adjectives of Shape</u>: round, square, etc.

For Example – There is a **square** box on a **round** table.

4. Adjectives of Taste: sweet, sour, etc.

For Example – This is a **sweet** apple.

5. Adjectives of Touch: hot, cold, etc.

For Example – I need a cup of **hot** coffee.

6. Adjectives of Sound: loud, soft, etc.

For Example – My mother has a **loud** voice

7. Adjectives of Numbers: few, many, two, etc.

For Example – **One** apple.

Many birds.

8. Adjectives of Feelings: angry, happy, sad, etc.

For Example – A <u>sad</u>boy.

A **happy** child.

9. <u>Adjectives of Behaviour</u>: nice, funny, rude, etc.

For Example – I met a <u>nice</u> gentleman.
