TOPIC : PRONOUNS

SYNOPSIS :

- **What are Nouns ?**

A word that names a person, place, animal or thing is called a **noun** or a **naming word**.

- **What are Pronouns ?**

Words that are used in place of naming words are called **pronouns**.

- **Uses of Pronouns :**

- The pronouns **I** and **me** are used when we talk about ourselves.
For Example : **I** am a good girl.
It took **me** five minutes to complete this work.
- The pronoun **you** is used when we are referring to the person we are talking to.
For Example : **You** have done good in all the subjects.
You are a good boy.
- The pronouns **he** or **him** are used when we talk about a boy.
For Example : **He** is my friend.
I gave **him** my book.
- The pronouns **she** and **her** are used when we talk about a girl.
For Example : **She** is very tall.
This is **her** pencil.
- The pronouns **they** and **them** are used when we talk about many people.
For Example : **They** are my friends.
I play with **them** everyday.
- The pronoun **it** is used when we talk about animals, babies and things.
For Example : **It** is a bat.
It is my pet cat.
- The pronouns **we** and **us** are used when we talk about ourselves and others.
For Example : **We** are going to the park.
The company gave **us** free movie tickets.

Important Note :

- The pronouns **I, me, you, he, she, it, her** and **him** are used with singular nouns.
- The pronouns **we, us, they** and **them** are used with plural nouns.
- The pronoun **you** can be used with both singular and plural nouns.

Few Examples :

1. Kirat is a boy. Kirat is a kind boy.
Kirat is a boy. **He** is a kind boy.
2. Kumar is going to the market. Kumar has to buy a book.
Kumar is going to the market. **He** has to buy a book.
3. This is my brother. My brother is older than me.
This is my brother. **He** is older than me.

In this sentence, the noun Kirat has been used twice in the same sentence. So here, we would replace the noun **Kirat** with pronoun **He** in the second part of the sentence.
