- In 622 CE, Muhammad left Mecca to Madina- Known as Hijrat.
- Caliph or Khalifa- ruled from 632 CE to 661 CE- succeeded Muhammad.
- Umayyids ruled from 661 CE to 750 CE.
- in 750 CE the Umayyids were overthrown by the Abbasids.
- Abbasids' ruled ended in 1258.
- Ottoman Empire became the capital of the Turks.
- Arabs became famous by trade.
- The Arabs were great scholars, scientists and physicians.
- The advanced Arab civilization was a link between ancient and modern world.
