- There are four kinds of Nouns :
 - COMMON NOUN-** It is the name of a person , an animal , a place or a thing in general. For example – girl , city , book etc
 - PROPER NOUN -.** It is this name of a person , an animal , a place or a thing in particular. For example – Mary , Delhi, Bible etc
 - COLLECTIVE NOUNS** - It is the name of a collection of people, animals or things. For example – herd , clump , bouquet etc
 - ABSTRACT NOUNS** – It is a noun that we cannot touch , see , hear , smell or taste. For example – kindness , hatred , poverty etc
