TOPIC- SAFETY AND FIRST AID

Accidents take place when people are careless or in a hurry. These accidents can be prevented (stopped) if we all try and cultivate safety habits.

In the classroom:- Use a pencil sharpener to sharpen your pencils. Do not play or hit one another with chalk or a duster. Do not jump on desks or benches or bang on doors and windows.

On the staircase:- Do not rush, pull or push one another on the stairs. Go up and down the stairs in a line.

In the playground:- Never play a rough game. Play the game with a sportsman spirit.

On the road:- Walk on the footpath or pavement. Look carefully in both directions before crossing the road. Cross the road at the zebra crossing and when the traffic signal shows green.

First Aid: - The first help given to a wounded person after an accident is called first aid.
