Most plants grow from seeds

- Most plants around us grow from seeds
- Plants usually bear flowers
E.G. – Lotus , Pea, Rose
- Some of these flowers also grow into fruits.
E.g. – Apple, Tomato , Pear
- Sometimes seeds are hidden inside a fruit. They also have different shapes and sizes.
E.g. – Pea Seeds , Orange Seeds , Coconut Seeds and Mango Seeds
- Every seed has a baby plant. It contains food stored in it and also helps the baby plant grow.
- The seed bursts when the baby plant grows bigger.
- In order to grow a baby plant needs
 1. Sunshine
 2. Water
 3. Air
 4. Food
