Tracing guide for uppercase X and lowercase x. Includes a hand illustration and handwriting practice lines.

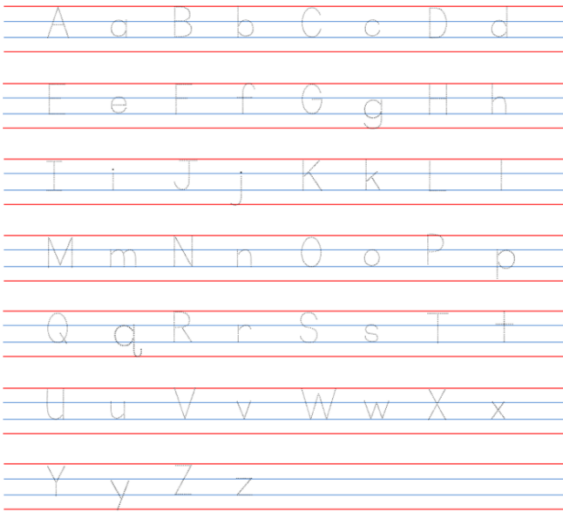
Tracing guide for uppercase Y and lowercase y. Includes a yellow splash illustration and handwriting practice lines.

- 5) Do Example 1 and 2 in your Four-line exercise book. Follow the examples given below.

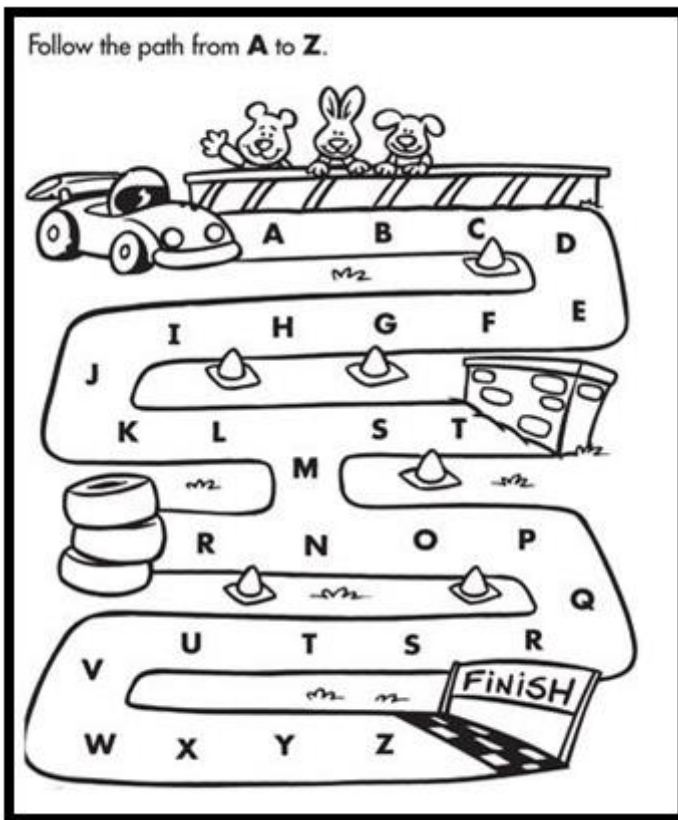
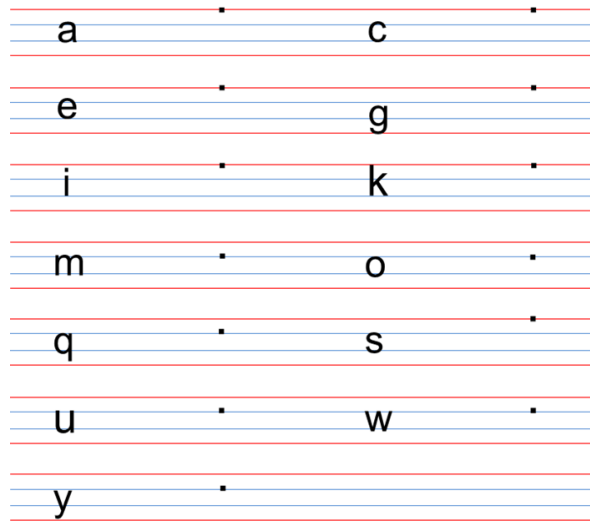
### Example 1
