SYNOPSIS

- ❖ A constitution is the fundamental law of the land.
- Our constitution was prepared after a great deal of discussion.
- The preamble is a short introduction to the Constitution. It states that India is a sovereign, socialist, secular, democratic republic. The Preamble also states the objectives of the Constitution- justice, liberty, equality and fraternity.
- ❖ The Directive principles of State Policy are guidelines for the government.
- Our constitution gives every citizen some basic rights. These are called fundamental Rights.
- ❖ The Constitution of India expects the citizens to perform certain duties towards the country. These are called Fundamental Duties.
