SYNOPSIS:-
The simple present tense is generally used for an action that is done regularly perhaps everyday. It is often used with such words as usually, generally, sometimes, always, everyday etc.
For example:-
1.Mary <u>dances</u> every day.
2.Tom usually <u>wakes up</u> every day at about six o'clock.
3.The sun always <u>rises</u> in the east.
4.Bats generally <u>fly</u> at night.
In these sentences, the verbs dances, wakes, rises, fly express an action that is done regularly. They are said to be in the <u>Simple Present Tense</u> .
