Delhi is the capital of India. It is the third largest city in India. The river Yamuna flows through the Eastern side of Delhi . **Delhi** shares its boundaries with the States of Haryana and Uttar pradesh. The President of India lives in the Rashtrapati Bhavan. The India Gate is another important landmark of Delhi. The Red Fort is made up of red sandstone. It was built by Emperor Shah Jahan. The Qutub Minar is a Very tall monument. The Jantar Mantar is an observatory. The Raj Ghat is the samadhi of Mahatma Gandhi. The Father of the Nation .

The Jama Masjid, The Birla Mandir, The St. James church, and the The Gurudwara sisganj are some famous places of worship. The

lotus temple built with white marble is a Bahaitemple built in the Shape of a lotus.

The climate of Delhi is very hot in Summer and very cold in Winter . Loo is a hot and dry winds that blows during May and June.
