- Sending and receiving messages is called communication.
  - The most common means of communication are letters which can be written on postcard, inland letter or in an envelope.
  - Urgent letter are sent through speed post or by courier service.
  - Mobiles or cellular phones are used to send short messages (SMS) or pictures on the phone.
  - Telephone is the fastest means of communication.
  - ISD is used for making international calls.
  - Newspaper, Radio and Television are called means of mass communication.
  - Newspapers carry messages throughout the country and in other parts of the world.
  - Television is the most popular means of communication.
  - Communication satellites have made communication faster.
  - Fax- E-Mail and internet are modern means of communication.
  - E-Mail carries messages from one computer to another.
  - Using a Fax machine, a letter can reach any part of the world in few minutes.
