**TOPIC : PRESENT CONTINUOUS TENSE**

**SYNOPSIS :**

The **present continuous tense** is used to describe actions that are taking place at the time of speaking.

In the continuous tense, the main verb has an – **ing** form.

**For Example :**

- The sun is **shining**.
- The clouds are **floating** across the blue sky.
- I am **playing**.

In the above sentences, the verbs shining, floating and playing are in continuous form as they have ing added to the main verb.

A continuous tense has a helping verb before the main verb

**For Example :**

- The sun **is** shining.  
    ↓  
    Helping Verb
- The clouds **are** floating across the blue sky.  
    ↓  
    Helping Verb
- I **am** playing.  
    ↓  
    Helping Verb

We use **is**, **are** and **am** to indicate present continuous tense.
