Adjectives are called describing words or a word which describes a noun (person, place, animal or thing) is called an adjective. There are different kinds of adjectives – Adjective of quality, adjective of quantity and adjective of number.

An adjective that tells us about the kind of person, place, animal or thing we are referring to is called an adjective of quality.

An adjective that tells us how much of a thing we are referring to is called an adjective of quantity. An adjective that tells us the number of persons, places, animals or things we are referring to or in what order is called an adjective of number.

One thing to remember is that the names of colours are also describing words.
