Plants grow in soil. Stones of different kind, shapes, sizes and colour are found in the soil. The soil and stones come from rocks. Many useful things such as coal, diamond, gold, silver rocks and other minerals are found in the earth.

Rocks are hard substances that are mostly found under the ground.

Rocks are of different kinds. They can be smooth or rough, hard or soft.

Different kinds of rocks have different names-

- Granite – It is a hard and rough rock.
- Marble- It is a soft and easy to cut. It is smooth.
- Sandstone- It is used to make buildings like Red Fort.
- Slate- It is a rock found in layers.
- Minerals – Minerals are substances found underground and are useful to us.
