Ans 2. Features of profession are :

(i) **Specialised body of knowledge**- Every profession has a specialised and systematised body of knowledge. Members of the profession are required to learn this knowledge.

(ii) **Restricted entry**- Entry to a profession is allowed only to those who have completed the prescribed education and have passed the specialized examination.

(iii) **Formal education and training**- A profession provides facilities for formal education and training to those who want to acquire profession qualification. One must acquire the prescribed degree examples- CA, LLB by undergoing the prescribed training.

(iv) **Professional association**- A professional association is a statutory body and its membership is essential. The association regulates entry in the profession, grants certificate of practice, formulates and enforces code of conduct.

(v) **Service motive**- Professionals are expected to emphasise services to their clients rather than economic gain.
