Q4. The parts of a system that can be seen and touched are called hardware. E.g. Keyboard, Mouse.

Q5. The CPU is called the brain of the computer because it controls all the functions of the computer.

Q6. The main components of the CPU are : a) Arithmetic Logic Unit b) Control Unit c) Memory Unit.

Arithmetic Logic Unit (ALU) does all the calculations and sends the result to the memory unit. **OR**

The Control Unit (CU) controls the working of all the parts of a computer and also helps in communication between the Memory unit and the ALU .**OR**

The Memory Unit (MU) stores the data , information and instruction that are used for processing.

Q7. The full form of IPO is Input Process Output.

You entered data into a computer and tell it what to do with the data.This is called Input.

The computer works on the data and produces a result. This is called Process.

The computer then displays the result. This result is called Output.
