<u>Ans:</u> Weather is the condition of atmosphere of a particular place for over a short period of time where as the climate is the kind of weather that a place has over a long period of time.

2. Name the five factors that influence the climate of a place.

Ans: The five factors that influence the climate of a place are:

- Distance from the Equator
- Altitude
- Distance from the sea
- Direction of winds
- Humidity

3. Why do places near the Equator have a hot climate?

Ans: The places near the Equator have a hot climate because the rays of the sun are more direct or perpendicular near the Equator. These rays fall over a smaller area and make the place hot.

4. Why is it colder in mountains than in the plains?

<u>Ans:</u> It is colder in mountains than in the plains because the climate of a place is also affected by its altitude, that is, the height of a place above the sea level. The higher the altitude, the colder the climate.


The temperature decreases by 1°C for every 165 metres above the sea level.

5. Why are Delhi and Amritsar hotter than Mumbai and Kolkata?




A. Three Climatic Zone
