Points to remember:

The words I, you, he, she, it, we and they have been used in place of naming words. They are called PRONOUNS

- We use I for our own self
- We use you for the person we are talking to. We also use you when we are speaking to more than one person
- We use he for a boy or a man
- We use she for a girl or a woman
- We use it for no living things, babies and animals
- We use we when we talk about ourselves along with someone else
- We use they when we talk of people/things that are more than one
