Understanding Multiples. When 2 or more numbers are multiplied the product is called the multiple of each of the numbers being multiplied.

Properties of multiples:

1. Every number is a multiple of itself. 2. Every number is a multiple of 1. 3. The smallest (first) multiple of a number is the number itself. 4. Every multiple of a number is equal to or greater than the number itself. 5. There is no largest multiple of a number as multiples are infinite. 6. A multiple of a number is divisible by the number. To find the Multiples of a number, multiply it by 1,2,3,4 and so on.

Common Multiples A number that is a multiple of 2 or more numbers is called a common multiple. Therefore 12 and 24 are common multiple s of 3 and 4.

Exercise 5.2.page 78.(B) numbers 1-5

Factors When 2 or more numbers are multiplied the answer is called the product. Each of the numbers being multiplied is called the factor of the product.

Properties of Factors:

1. 1 is a factor of all numbers. 2. 1 is the smallest factor of a number. 3. A number is a factor of itself. 4. A number itself is the greatest factor of itself. 5. The factor of a number is smaller than or equal to the number. 6. Every number (except 1) has atleast 2 factors, that is, 1 and itself.

Finding Factors using multiplication. For example :find the factors of 18 Factors of 18 can be 1×18 , 2×9 , 3×6 So the factors of 18 are 1, 2, 3, 6, 9, 18

Finding Factors using division. For

example.find the factors of 18 18 \div 1 = 18 , 18 \div 2 = 9 , 18 \div 3 = 6 18 \div 6 = 3 , 18 \div 9 = 2 , 18 \div 18 = 1 Therefore the factors of 18 are 1,2,3,6,9&18
