# Geography

#### **Topic - Water bodies (oceans and seas)**

### **Synopsis**

- **Hydrosphere**: The part of the Earth's surface occupied by water bodies is called **Hydrosphere**.
- An Ocean is a huge body of saltwater. Oceans can cover nearly 71% of the Earth surface.
- They contain almost 98% of all the water on the earth.
- There are five main oceans :
- The Pacific Ocean: It is the largest ocean on the Earth which covers about one third of the earth.
- The Atlantic Ocean: It is the busiest ocean of the world.
- Indian ocean: It is bounded by land masses on three sides.
- Arctic Ocean: It is the smallest ocean of the world and remains covered with ice for most of the Year.
- The southern Ocean : it is also referred to as the Antarctic Ocean, South Pole Ocean and Great Southern Ocean.
- Smaller part of these oceans are called seas, gulfs and bays.
- Ocean Life :
- Living things inhabit all levels of Earth's ocean.
- Sunlight penetrates the water to only about 600 feet (200 meters)
- The most numerous ocean plants are called **phytoplankton**.
- The largest ocean animal is the blue whale.
- The tiniest animal are a form of plankton called **zooplanktons**.
- Importance of oceans:
- Oceans are a great source of food for people around the world.
- They also provide minerals, oil and natural gas.
- Phytoplankton and algae create much of the world's oxygen.
- Ocean currents has a direct impact on the climate of a place.
- Warm currents bring warm weather and rain whereas cold currents tend to cause dry climate.
