HTML stands for Hyper Text Mark-up Language. It is a language used to create web pages. The HTML document is written in a Text Editor and viewed in a Web Browser. The elements give structure to the document and are enclosed within tags. Various attributes define the features of the web page. The basic structure of the HTML document comprises of the Head and the Body. Various HTML tags are- HTML, Head, Title, Body, Heading, Paragraph, Line Break, etc.
