TOPIC - RURAL LOCAL AND SELF-GOVERNMENT

Synopsis :

- A group of people living together in a place is called a **community**.
- **Need for local self government :** To make governance easy and more efficient, local self- governments have been formed.
- The local self governing bodies are of two kinds: Rural and Urban,
- a) Panchayati Raj is the local self government body e that functions in rural areas.
- b) The municipality is a local self government body that functions in urban areas.
- Structure of Panchayati Raj system: In ancient times villages in India settle disputes and other problems through a body called Panchayat. The word 'panchayat' means assembly of five elders of panches.
- The Panchayati Raj is a three tier system. It works at three levels-
- 1. The Gram Panchayat at the village level which consists of three main bodies
- a) The Gram Sabha
- b) The Gram Panchayat
- c) The Nyaya Panchayat

2. **The Block Samiti** at the block level works as an essential link between the Gram Panchayat and the Zila Parishad. Members of a block Samiti are elected for a term of five years.

3. The District Level. The **Zila Parishad** is highest body of the Panchayati Raj system. The Zila Parishad is responsible for the development of rural areas of the whole district state.

- State Governments and Panchayati Raj:
- The state governments formulate rules and regulations regarding the functioning of the Panchayati Raj system.
- In a country like us the role of Panchayati Raj system is very important. It addresses the problem and needs of the local people and helps to bring about a social change.
