## **TOPIC- PREPOSITIONS**

### SYNOPSIS:

 A Preposition is a word that shows the relation between a noun or pronoun and some other word in the sentence.

#### KINDS OF PREPOSITIONS:

- Prepositions of time: These prepositions are used to indicate the time of an action. E.g: He lives at Mumbai in India.
- Prepositions of place: They indicate the place where something is located. E.g. The children sat on the ground.
- Prepositions of Direction: They indicate the direction of something. I saw a dog run across the garden.

#### PLACEMENT OF PREPOSITIONS

- A Preposition is is usually followed by a noun or a pronoun. E.g. The book is <u>on</u> the desk.
- A Preposition is placed before the object. However, sometimes it is placed after the object to form questions. E.g. What are you looking at ?
- When the object of a preposition is used as a subject the preposition is placed at the end
  of the sentence. E.g. The sky was too bright to look <u>at.</u>
- Sometimes a sentence may start with prepositional phrase. E.g. <u>After</u> the match, we went out to have dinner.
