1. Smallest and biggest numbers. - When we have a Two digit number, we see the Tens house first. If the numbers are the same, we see the Ones house and accordingly we pick the biggest and smallest number. When we have three digit numbers, we first see the Hundreds house. If the numbers in the Hundred house are different, we are able to choose the biggest / smallest number and do not have to look at the Tens or Ones house. However, if the numbers in the Hundreds house are the same then we look at the numbers in the Tens house and if the numbers in the Tens house are the same we then, look at the numbers in the Ones house to pick the biggest or smallest number.


