Domestic And Other Useful Animals

We keep some animals as pets, these are called domestic animals. Milch animals are those animals who give us milk. Some birds give us eggs. Animals also give us meat, leather and wool. The silkworm gives us silk fibers to make silk cloth. Some animals carry our load, they are called Beasts of Burden. They are also used for riding. Some animals help the farmers in ploughing the fields and to carry our field products. Dogs keep the stray animals away. Honeybees make honey from the nectar of flowers.
