Points to remember:

Doing words or action words tell us what a person or an animal is doing. All action words or doing words are **verbs**.

Sometimes we use 's' or 'es' to verbs when they are used with singular nouns or pronouns.

Verbs remain unchanged when they are used with plural nouns or pronouns.

With the pronouns **I and You** verbs remain unchanged.

Action words also tell us what animals do.

How an animal moves.

How an animal makes noise.
