**Synopsis:**

- A pronoun is a word that is used in place of a noun.
- Pronoun is divided into Personal pronoun Possessive pronoun and Demonstrative pronoun.
- The pronouns I, we, he, she, it, they, her, him, them, us, me and you are called personal pronouns.
- Personal pronoun is further divided into first person, second person, and third person.
- Pronouns that show possession are called possessive pronoun.
- Pronouns that are used to point out nouns are called demonstrative pronouns.
