<u>Verbs</u>

- Verbs are words that show action. They tell us what people, animals and things are, what they have and what they do, think, say or feel.
- The verbs that tell us about actions that take place regularly are in the Simple Present Tense.
- We use the Present Continuous Tense to talk about an action that is still going on at the time of speaking.
- Verbs in the Past Tense tell us about actions that took place some time ago.
- We use the Past Continuous Tense to talk about an action that was going on at some point of time in the past.
- Verbs in the Future Tense describes actions that are expected to take place later.
