Food for animals

Animals like cows, goats, horses, zebras, elephants, deer and camels eat grass and leaves .These animals are called grass eating animals.

Animals like lions, tigers eat flesh of other animals. Such animals are called flesh eating animals. Some animals like hens, sparrows, pigeons eat grains. These animals are called grain eating animals. Some animals have a sticky tongue. They use their sticky tongue to catch insects for their food. Such animals are called insect eating animals. Examples: lizards, frogs, spider A spider can trap an insect in its web. Once the insect gets trapped it becomes food for the spider.
