- The adjectives that indicate the quantity of something are called **adjectives of quality**.
E.g: Tanya is a **happy** child.
- Adjectives that tell us the quantity of nouns are called **adjectives of quantity**.
E.g: This beach has **many** stones and **a lot of** sand.
- Adjectives that tell us the exact number of nouns or their order are called **adjectives of numbers**. E.g: I borrowed **two** books from the library.
