Articles – The words a, an and the are used to point out nouns and are called articles. We use **a** before a word that begins with a consonant. Ex – a cow, a deer. We use **an** before a word that begins with a vowel. Ex – an apple, an umbrella. Articles **a, an** are used to talk about a thing in general. Article **the** is used when we talk about the same nouns, the second time, that is about a particular thing. Article **the** is also used to introduce plural nouns. Ex- the bicycles, the pencils etc.
