- A type of selection used to select an irregular part of a picture.

3) Write the steps to save a picture.

Ans – The steps to save a picture are as follows: -

1. Click on the Paint button.
2. Click on the Save option. The Save As dialog box appears.
3. Type a name for the drawing in File name box.
4. Click on the Save button.

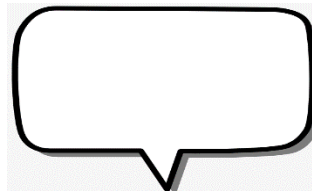
4) Write the steps to copy and paste a picture.

Ans – The steps to copy and paste a picture are as follows: -

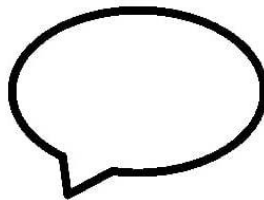
1. Select the part of the picture you want to copy.
2. In the Clipboard group on the Home tab, click on Copy.
3. In the Clipboard group on the Home tab, click on Paste. The copied picture will appear in the top – left corner of the screen.
4. Click and drag the picture to place it where you want.
