Fun with Paint

- The callout shapes in the Shapes group are mainly used to display dialogues and thoughts.
- The Tools group has tools such as Pencil, Fill with color, Eraser, Text, Color picker and Magnifier.
- A picture can be selected using any of these 3 options: Rectangular selection, Free – form selection and Select all.
- A picture can be moved using Cut and Paste options.
- Copies of a picture can be made using Copy and Paste option.
- The Resize option is used to resize a picture or a portion of it.
- A picture can be saved in different file types such as .jpeg, .png, .bmp and .gif.
