SUBJECT: SCIENCE WORKSHEET TOPIC: HABITS FOR SAFETY

The word **safety** means the quality or condition of being safe. Freedom from danger, injury or damage. To be safe we must follow some rules such as:

Safety at home: Do not play with sharp objects such as knives, blades and scissors. Do not play with candles ,matchboxes and gas stove. Put away your books or toys after using them.If you get hurt inform your parents.

Safety at play: Play in a safe place such as a park. Never play on the road. Do not push or pull others while playing. Wait for your turn on swing or slide.

Safety on the road: Always following the traffic lights. Walk on the footpath. Cross the road only at the zebra crossing. Never run on the road.

Safety in the school bus: Stand in a queue while waiting for the bus. Wait for your turn to get into the bus. Do not lean out of the bus window. Do not throw things out of a moving bus. You may hurt someone.

In the pool: Do not swim alone in a pool. Use an air tube whi le learning to swim. Swim under the care of elders.
