- a) How did people show their protest against the British under Mahatma Gandhi's leadership?

Ans:- Under the leadership of Mahatma Gandhi people led peaceful protest movements. People marched peacefully, disobeyed British laws, refused to buy, sell or use British made goods and refused to work in offices run by the British.

- b) What did Vallabhbhai Patel ask the peasants to do ? What did the British do ?
