- a) What are monuments ? Write two sentences about any one monument.

**Ans:- Monuments are special buildings. Some of them are built to remind people of a famous person or an event. Forts, temples, palaces, pillars etc are all monuments.**

**The Konark Sun Temple is one of the most famous temples in Odisha. It was built more than 700 years ago by a ruler called Narasimhadeva I. ( Refer to your text book to know about some more monuments. )**

- b) What are epics ? Name our two epics.

**Ans:- Epics are long poems that tells us the story of heroes and their adventures.. The Ramayana and The Mahabharata are our two epics.**

- c) What are folktales ?

**Ans:- Folktales are stories told by people and passed from one generation to another. There is no one author for a folktale. Thus, it is told differently by different people.**
