

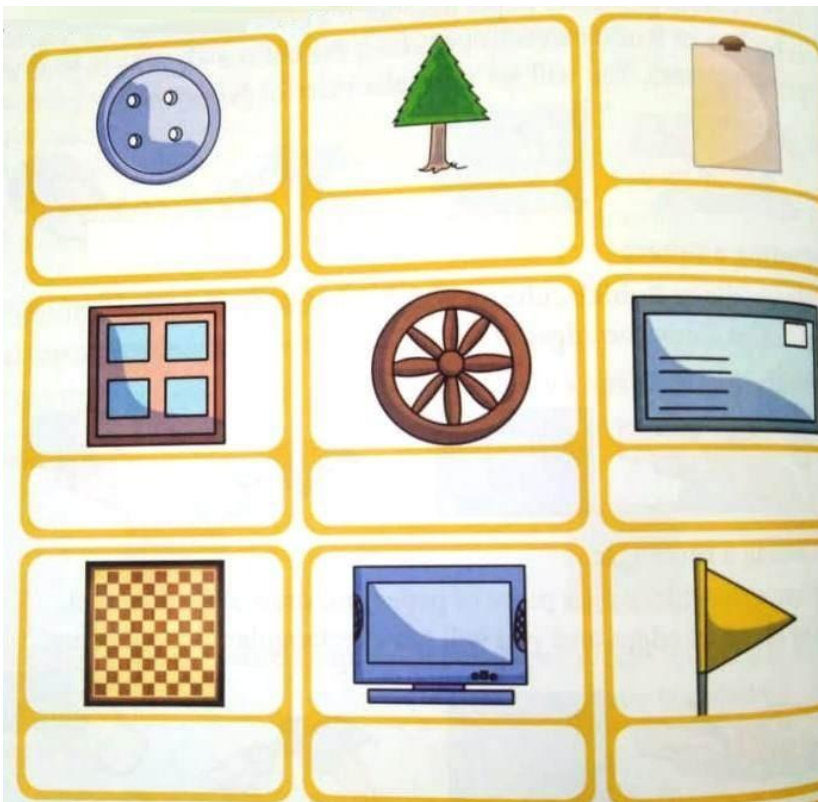
SYNOPSIS**Shapes**

Shapes are made up of lines. There are two types of lines, a straight line and a curved line. There are mainly two types of shapes, Flat or 2D Shapes and Solid or 3D Shapes.

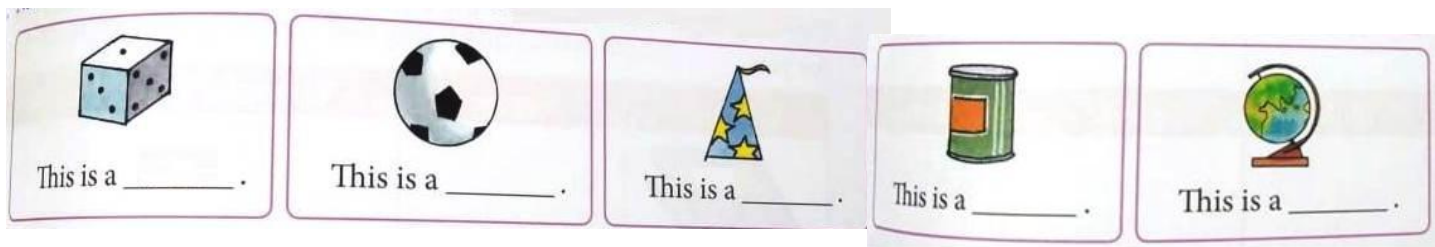
Flat Shapes are Circle, Square, Rectangle and Triangle. Solid Shapes are Cube, Cuboid, Sphere, Cylinder and Cone. Solids that have flat surfaces can slide down a sloping surface. Solids that have curved surfaces can roll down a sloping surface.
