SYNOPSIS:

- There are some animals that we keep at home and in farms. These are known as Domestic animals.
 - Animals such as dogs, cats, rabbits, fish, etc are often kept as pets. Cows, goats, hens, ducks, horses and sheep are some farm animals.
- Domestic animals help us in many ways. They give us food and other products.
 We get milk from cows, buffaloes and goats. They are called Milch animals.
 Milk is an important part of our diet. Milk is used to make butter, cheese, curd, ghee, etc.
- Birds give us eggs. We get eggs from hens and ducks.
- Animals give us meat. Some people eat the meat of hen, cock, sheep, goat, etc.
- Animals give us wool and silk.
 - We get wool from sheep. Wool is used to make sweaters, caps, mufflers, etc. We get silk from silkworm. Silk is used to make sarees, scarves, etc.
- Animals also help us in other ways :
 - Horses, oxen, camels, elephants and donkeys carry our loads. These animals are called Beasts of Burden.
 - Camels and horses are used for riding.
 - Oxen plough the fields.
 - Some animals help us to travel from place to place.
- Honeybees give us honey.
 - Pets are our friends. It is fun to play with them. They help us in many ways: Cats catch mice.
 - Dogs guard our homes and also help to keep the stray animals away from the fields.
- Animals give us leather.
 - When animals such as buffaloes, camels, goats, etc die, their skin is used to make leather. Leather is used to make bags, belts, shoes, jackets, etc.
