## **TOPIC: NOUNS**

## **SYNOPSIS:**

- Nouns: A naming word is called a noun. It is a word that names a person, place, animal or thing. There are four kinds of nouns but we will be doing Proper Nouns and Common Nouns.
- <u>Proper Nouns</u>: A noun which names a particular person, place, animal or thing is called a Proper Noun. A proper noun always begins with a **capital letter**. For Example
  - a) Person (Mohan Das)
  - **b)** Place (Kolkata)
  - c) Names of Months (May)
  - d) Days of the week (Monday)

Names of streets, rivers, countries and festivals are all Proper Nouns.

• <u>Common Nouns:</u> A common noun does not point out to any particular person, place, animal or thing but is common to all person and things. The words book, pen, river, mountain, animal, city, train and bird are all common nouns.

For Example – The name **girl** can be given to any girl. It does not point to any particular girl, therefore it is a common noun.
